### OUR DEEPEST NEEDS

The word of God serves up a tremendous feast for us today. Isaiah beckons all who hunger and thirst to come to the Lord for satisfaction. The psalmist cries out, "The hand of the Lord feeds us; he answers all our needs" (Psalm 145:16). Saint Paul tells us that nothing can separate us from the love of God. Finally, in the Gospel, we hear the story of the miraculous feeding of over five thousand people from a mere five loaves and two fish. Most of us have our material needs met on a day-to-day basis. These scriptures, nevertheless, have much to say to the contemporary believer. We must ask ourselves, "Where are my deepest hungers? Where are my thirsts?" After material needs are satisfied and, in some cases, over-satisfied, many people still experience a deep longing for spiritual balance and well-being. As the loaves and fish are multiplied in today's Gospel, perhaps our prayer can be a longing for the satisfaction of the deepest needs that only God can fill. (c) Copyright, J. S. Paluch Co.

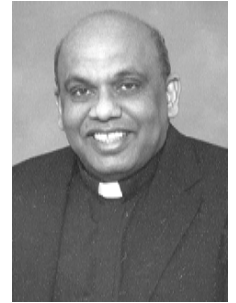

## Pastor's Note



Dear Parishioners,

I am writing this letter with great urgency. For the last several weeks we have been announcing after mass the need for catechists. We have also made many requests in the bulletin for help in teaching the children of our parish, but there are still not enough teachers for our faith formation classes.

One of our responsibilities as fully initiated practicing Catholics is to pass on our faith to the younger generation. Not only is it our responsibility, it is our baptismal calling. We must teach and train our children and all those who desire it, but it takes many of you helping to accomplish this. We are expecting close to 700 students this September. To effectively minister to them and have a successful program we need you to respond to this call. Training is provided throughout the year to help you in this ministry. Also consider the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd Program. It's a bit more training, but well worth the effort. CGS Training begins August 1st.

Recently I spoke to you about the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. RCIA will begin August 4th at 6:45 pm. Perhaps you know someone that has not finished with their sacraments of initiation. Talk to them and encourage them to check out the RCIA process so that they may fully participate in our treasure of faith. You may even be able to sponsor them on their journey.

Finally, as you read this letter I will be on my way to Sri Lanka. In case of an emergency or if you need to speak to a priest please contact one of our neighboring parishes. I will be visiting my family and attending a school reunion. Please pray that I may enjoy a safe trip home.

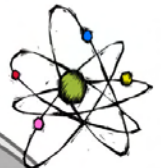

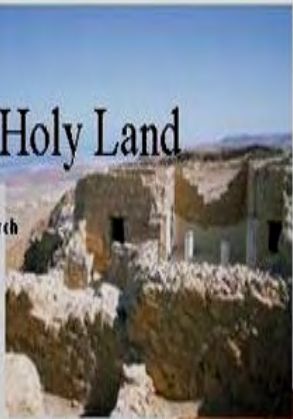

**FEAST OF FAITH**

**The Preface: Thanksgiving**

The preface of the Mass has been called “a poem, the cry of joy and recognition, the song of the world discovering its salvation . . . the certitude of faith making hope spring forth” (Philippe Béguerie, quoted in *The Mass*, Lucien Deiss, The Liturgical Press, Collegeville, MN, 1992, p. 70). The preface takes up the last words of the dialogue, and expresses briefly and simply why we are grateful, why it is right and just to give thanks and praise to God. On feast days, the preface sings of the specific mystery or saint we celebrate; in Ordinary Time, the Sunday and weekday prefaces express our gratitude for God’s gift of the Son, Jesus Christ, in whom we have redemption and newness of life. The prefaces offer a succinct account of what God has done for us in Christ; they express the mystery of faith, always relating it to us, to our lives. “By his birth we are reborn,” we hear in Preface IV for Sundays in Ordinary Time. “By his suffering we are freed from sin. By his rising from the dead we rise to everlasting life.” Yes, we have cause to give God thanks and praise.

**CATECHISTS and ASSISTANTS for CGS, Faith Formation, and Confirmation**



The ministry of catechist is one of the oldest ministries of the Church. A “catechist” is one who teaches the principles of Christian dogma, discipline and ethics to prepare people for participation in Christian life. The word “catechesis” means to echo or to resound, an appropriate meaning for what a catechist does in passing of the faith tradition to the children of our parish.

If you can respond to this call, there are openings on:

- ◆ Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays for 4th grade through 8th grade either at 4:00pm-5:30pm or 6:00pm-7:30pm, as well as on Saturday mornings from 9:30am-11:00am. The Wednesday sessions are Sacrament preparation classes. Training is ongoing throughout the year.
- ◆ Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays for CGS assistants. Children range from 3 years old through 3rd grade. Training is scheduled for Monday August 1, 2011 from 9am to 4pm at the parish.
- ◆ Sundays for 9th through 11th grade at 10:00am followed by attendance at the 12:00pm Mass.

To be a catechist, you must:

- be a practicing Catholic
- be in communion with the Church
- complete a Ministry application
- be fingerprinted and attend the *Protecting God's Children* program
- continue your own faith formation

**Are you a fully initiated**

**Catholic?** —One that has received not only Baptism and 1st Eucharist, but also the sacrament of Confirmation. If the answer is NO, then RCIA is for you. Also, if you or someone you know is considering becoming Catholic, come to a Thursday evening meeting at 7 pm and see what it is all about. The process is very interesting. Practicing Catholics are also needed to sponsor those who wish to join the church. Come, learn, ask questions **and make friends.**

## Sacrament of Baptism
