#### **JOSE SN CRISOSTOMO**

Please pray for Jose "Sinbad" San Nicolas Crisostomo, who was called to his eternal rest while doing what he knew best— protecting our freedom. He served in multiple conflicts, including: Vietnam, Desert Shield/Desert Storm, and Afghanistan. Jose was a Purple Heart recipient, and was twice awarded the Bronze Star. His leadership was invaluable in both the military and civilian communities, particularly within the Chamorro Culture. At 59 years of age, he is the oldest American soldier to die in combat. He is survived by his wife, three children, and 10 grandchildren.



He is loved, honored, and will be greatly missed by his family here in Las Vegas, Washington State, and in his home island, Guam USA.

## Pastor's Notes

Dear Parishioners,

Everyone has their own idea of what "belonging to a parish" means. Some feel that because they attend services here, or if they become involved in a particular ministry within the parish that they are somehow automatically on the roster. Some think it's only about money. Others feel that it's their own business and no one else needs to know as long as the Lord knows that they worship somewhere.

These notions are understandable, *considering how things used to be*. Remember when:

1. parishes were small neighborhood gatherings in which everyone knew everyone else
2. there were many priests and religious, monasteries and convents that helped to keep the churches up and running and indeed even helped to support them.

Unfortunately, this is no longer the case. The way in which the church operates these days has had to change over the years. We now have mega-churches and it is impossible to know all the members without an organized method. Additionally, reports/statistics must be made to the diocese upon which many important decisions concerning not only our parish, but Catholics nationwide will be made. It is important for you to be counted among these numbers. There are also reasons why you, personally, would *want* to be registered:

- Receiving parish mailings, schedules and emails
- Getting letters from the pastor for permission to sponsor, baptize, marry, etc.
- Making sure that your children can register to receive faith formation/religious education
- Many other benefits, too numerous to mention

### The "official" definition of a registered parishioner:

"An individual who is formally registered in the parish includes receiving all parish mailings, as well as the weekly offertory envelopes. A registered parishioner will make regular meaningful and identifiable contributions according to their means (using the parish tithe envelopes or using checks). A registered parishioner will attend the Sunday liturgy at their parish of registration a minimum of thirty-five Sundays per year. The parish tithe envelope or checks will be used to register attendance."

It is so easy to register and it benefits you, the parish and the Catholic community as a whole. Please take a moment to officially include yourself in this community if you have not yet done so. Welcome flyers are in the lobby with registration forms inside. Take one, fill out the form and drop it in the collection basket or return it to the office. Or just come by the office to see us during business hours. We'll be happy to help.

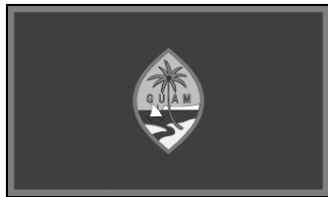
